

Daylilies

These beauties are among the easiest perennials to grow! Practically any soil type is suitable for a tough clump of summer blooming daylilies.



They aren't bothered by road salt, slopes, or city pollutants and are hardy in zones 3 - 9. Most of the newer hybrids are not as invasive as older varieties of daylily. All daylilies do their best in full sun, putting on a vibrant show in nearly every color in the rainbow:





Flower size ranges from a cute little 2" to a whopping 7" across. Some of the smaller varieties are fabulous as potted plants:



Other daylilies, such as the very well known, reblooming 'Stella de Oro', are superb landscape plants.



Modern varieties of daylily should only be divided every 3 - 4 years in spring or fall, but they become especially striking when allowed to form a mass planting. Their solid bank of color makes a real statement in your yard in midsummer. Truly an excellent choice for beginner or master gardener!
