

Water Plants!

Floating Plants provide rapid surface cover, shading the pond water and providing a protected space for fish to escape the mid-day sun. They compete with algae for nutrients in the water to help keep it clear. Very rapid growth habits! Annuals.



Submerged Plants are a must to compete with algae for the nutrients in the water and keeping the pond clear. Use one bunch of plants per one to two square feet of surface area. Annuals.



Hardy Bog Plants add color and shape to your water garden. Perennials in USDA Hardiness Zone 5, when properly planted and over-wintered.



Hardy Water Lilies bloom continuously all summer once established. They provide shade, use nutrients in the water, and protect the water from day/night temperature fluctuations. Perennials in USDA Hardiness Zone 5, when properly planted and over-wintered.
